When your interest is made known to us (from the date of your application)

Within two days (48 hours)

You will receive an automated e-mail confirming that we have received your application. A membership officer from your local lodge will contact you to arrange a meeting.

Within 4 weeks

The Lodge Membership Officer will arrange to meet you at a mutually convenient place and time to discuss (informally) your interest in Freemasonry. If you are interested in proceeding with your application we will take some personal details from you for the purpose of progressing your application.

Within 6-12 months

You will be invited to attend a Committee Meeting with the Brethren of the Lodge. You will also be invited to attend social functions associated with the Lodge that will allow the Brethren to get to know you.

At any stage during your application process you or the Lodge are entitled to withdraw the application.

You will be invited to the Masonic Centre where the Lodge meets, allowing you to be introduced to the current Lodge members.

The Lodge Membership Officer will introduce you to the Brethren where you will have the opportunity to discuss any matters relating to Freemasonry.

Subject to satisfactory interview you will be contacted and invited to be formally initiated into the Lodge where your Masonic journey will continue.

After we receive your application:

There are 25 freemason lodges within West Wales with over 1300 members across the province.

Due to the rural nature of West Wales the lodge closest to your residence will be notified of your online application.

Initial application contact will be via the Provincial Secretary (details shown below).

The most appropriate lodge to your location will be notified of your application.

The lodge Membership Officer will make contact with you within 48 hours of receiving your email.
